

## **The Alton D. Brashear Postgraduate Course in Head and Neck Anatomy**

A five-day course entitled "The Alton D. Brashear Postgraduate Course in Head and Neck Anatomy" will be held at the Virginia Commonwealth University School of Medicine from March 9-13, 2009. This annual course was named in memory of Dr. Alton D. Brashear, a long-time surgical anatomist in the Department of Anatomy and Neurobiology whose knowledge of head and neck anatomy enriched the lives all who were privileged to work with him.

The primary teaching method is the dissection of the head and neck. Lectures, demonstrations and audiovisuals demonstrating specific anatomical relationships of organs and organ systems, will augment the laboratory dissections. The course is approved for 43 credit hours by the Academy of General Dentistry.

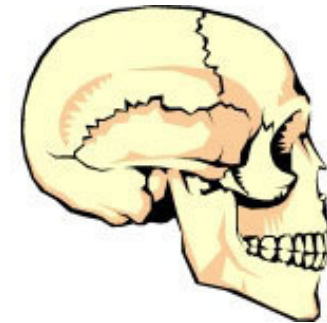
